Local business to deliver CCTV

There will soon be extra eyes watching over Halifax and Davenport as part of efforts to improve security for local businesses.

Closed-circuit television will be installed in November by Bunbury business BTS.

The works form part of a wider project designed to improve security, safety, access and infrastructure.

Made possible with \$3 million in State Government funding, the initiative will involve the installation of CCTV, improving the road network by installing a slip lane, and providing a sewerage upgrade.

The first component of the project is being managed by the Bunbury Geographe Chamber of Commerce and Industry. It will involve the installation of CCTV at 22 strategic locations.

Additional lighting will also be installed.

Bunbury MLA Don Punch praised the hard work of local business owners who called for better security measures in the area in order to create better opportunities for businesses to succeed in Bunbury.

"The CCTV project is part of a \$3 million commitment the State Government has made to improving the Halifax Business Park. I am really pleased to see work now getting underway, and being performed by a local company," Mr Punch.

"I want Bunbury businesses to prosper, to contribute to our economy and to create jobs for our community, and investments like this are really important if we are to grow and develop our business community."
